CanSkate Welcome Letter 2025-2026

Hello and welcome to an exciting new skating season! This letter will hopefully answer those FAQs and give you some information as to what we have planned over the next few months!

Our CanSkate Program

We have 7 NCCP certified coaches: Beth, Marg, Arlene, Emma, Emily (our CanSkate Coordinator), Payton and Lexie leading this program along with several Program Assistants. Program Assistants are club skaters and parents that volunteer their time. They are essential to our program's success! The main objective of our program is to teach the basics of skating for all ice sports. The CanSkate program contains six stages, which are broken down into three subcategories; agility, balance and control.

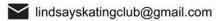
Session Schedule & Format

- Monday and Wednesday 5:30pm-6:15pm Pad 2
- Dressing room assignments will be posted on the monitor in the lobby, and there are often signs on the dressing room doors.
- Warm-up (on ice for CanSkate, off ice for PreCan), rotation through 3 circuits, group activity, and cool-down
- As you enter Pad 2, there will be a sign-in table with skater name tags and attendance chart. Each week skaters will:
 - o Pick up their name tag
 - o Place a sticker beside their name for attendance
- Once dressed skaters are asked to walk to the far (Zamboni) end of the Pad 2 to enter the ice.
- At the end of each session, Program Assistants will collect name tags. If a skater leaves before we can collect theirs, please have them place it on the sign-in table on the way out.

Helmets & Clothing

- Skaters are required to wear CSA approved hockey helmets until they have passed Stage
 5 CanSkate.
- We also recommend that skaters dress warmly in layers (mittens/gloves, splash pants or snow pants for younger skaters) to stay comfortable on the ice.





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Important Dates:

- Our first session of the season begins on October 6th and October 8th, 2025
- Our last session before the holidays is December 15, 2025
- Skating resumes on January 5, 2026 after the holidays
- No skating on October 13 (Thanksgiving) and February 16, 2026 (Family Day)
- Our final session of the season is March 16, 2026
- Ice show practice begins on March 18 or 22, 2026 (date will be confirmed at a later time)
- Tentative ice show date is Saturday April 4, 2026

Theme Days:

- Halloween October 27th and October 29th
- Holiday Gala/Family Skate December 17th
- Valentine's Day February 9th and 11th

Report Cards:

- December 10 and 15
- March 9 and 11
