Physical Literacy

Physical literacy is a core component of the Club Modernization program. It's designed to make skaters more athletically well-rounded, fit, strong, and flexible—all of which make skating skills easier to learn and perform.

This year, we are offering multiple physical literacy classes by level:

- Mondays & Wednesdays in the Community Room
- Sundays at Fortitude Fitness

b Skaters are required to participate in these classes and must wear running shoes. Training includes **jump and spin technique off the ice**, helping skaters progress faster when they return to the ice.

If your skater cannot attend, please notify Beth, just as you would for an on-ice absence.

Assessment Weeks

New this year: we will hold Assessment Week at the end of each month.

- Focus will be on feedback, assessments, or practice assessments
- If your skater is ready for an official Skate Canada assessment, please send the \$12.00 test fee by e-transfer before the test date
- Include your skater's **name and the test** they are attempting in the memo line

Team Coaching

Our club continues to grow, and with that growth comes the strength of team coaching. This model, supported by Skate Ontario's modernization program, ensures skaters benefit from the expertise of multiple coaches.

- Assessments (esp. dance) are supported by coach partners and evaluators
- Majority of lessons will be group, semi-private, or class-based (approx. 75% of ice time)
- Individual lessons may also be given
- All group lessons are included in registration fees; families may be billed separately for competition coaching, music cutting, or out-of-club assessments
